

# Brazos County Household Waste Collection Stations

Brazos County provides the use of trash compactor facilities located around the county as a service to rural county residents to ensure proper disposal of household solid waste, cutting down on littering and trash burning. A rural resident may deposit garbage at any facility. Please note that only certain locations handle large solid waste.

## Locations

Use the map at the right to find the most convenient location for your needs.

### 1. Precinct 1 – 21303 Kathy Fleming Road

Located approximately 1.0 mile off FM159

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal).

**Waste Not Accepted:** White goods<sup>1</sup>, commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.

### 2. Precinct 2 – 12722 Copperhead Rd

Copperhead Rd is off of FM 2038 .20 miles from SH 21.

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal), white goods<sup>1</sup>.

**Waste Not Accepted:** Commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.

### 3. Precinct 3 – 10940 State Hwy 30

Located approximately 1¾ miles off FM 158

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal).

**Waste Not Accepted:** White goods<sup>1</sup>, commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.

### 4. Precinct 4 – 7250 Raymond Stotzer Pkwy

Located 0.4 mile west of Old Jones Rd

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal).

**Waste Not Accepted:** White goods<sup>1</sup>, commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.

### 5. Precinct 4 – 9125 Mumford Road

Located 0.6 mile south of OSR

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal), white goods<sup>1</sup>.


**Waste Not Accepted:** Commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.

### 6. Precinct 4 – 1495 Silver Hill Road

Located off Hwy 21 W, ¼ mi W of Smetana Community

**Acceptable Waste:** Non-hazardous household waste (bagged 35-55 gal).

**Waste Not Accepted:** White goods<sup>1</sup>, commercial or industrial waste, building materials, hazardous materials<sup>2</sup>, brush, and tires.



<sup>1</sup> White goods include freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, washers/dryers, water heaters, etc.

<sup>2</sup> Hazardous materials include batteries, paint, oil, grease, fertilizers, etc.
