ORDER LIFTING RESTRICTIONS ON OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Brazos County Commissioners Court ordered, at its August 18, 2020 meeting, that restrictions on outdoor burning in the unincorporated areas of Brazos County, Texas, which are designated to become effective on August 18, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, at the August 18, 2020 meeting, the Brazos County Commissioners Court designated that the Brazos County Judge have the authority to terminate this Order in accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081 (c) (2); and,

WHEREAS, the Brazos County Judge has considered the recent rains and determined that the circumstances present on September 4, 2020, in the unincorporated areas of Brazos County that created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, no longer exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Brazos County Judge that the previous order of August 18, 2020, which banned outdoor burning, is lifted and the restrictions set forth are removed until such time as the Brazos County Commissioners Court may take further action regarding the same.
