PERMIT PROCESS FOR GATHERINGS OF 100 OR MORE

As ordered by the Governor of the State of Texas in Executive Order GA-28, any outdoor gatherings in excess of 100 people, in an unincorporated area must be approved by the County Judge. In order to maintain the health and safety of the public, all submitted applications will be reviewed to assess that proper measures will be taken to protect the participants of the event.

An application from the coordinator, manager, organizer or promoter of such an event must be received in to the County Judge's office not less than 10 business days before the event. The application is available online at brazoscountytexas.gov and must be completed and submitted online.

Once the application has been received, representatives from the Brazos County Health Department, Fire Marshal, and the Sheriff's Office will be notified of the submitted application and given the opportunity to review the application to ensure that minimum standards in health and sanitation, fire safety and public safety and order are maintained at the gathering as prescribed by state and local laws, rules and orders.

Following the review and approval process by the county health office, fire marshal and the Sheriff's Office, the County Judge will grant or deny the permit as authorized by the Governor of the State of Texas' Executive Orders.
